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JOURNEY'S END COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 13, 2022

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the April 13, 2022, Regular Board Meeting of the Journey's End Community Development District (the "District") to order at 7:05 p.m. in the Conference Room at Journey's End Clubhouse located at 6400 Journey's End Drive, Lake Worth, Florida 33467.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on November 2, 2021, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairman Alex Da Costa, Vice Chairman Alfred Marten and Supervisors Jeff Bates and Nancy Samuels constituted a quorum.

Staff in attendance were: District Manager Jason Pierman of Special District Services, Inc.; General Counsel Scott Cochran of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey; and District Engineer Karen Brandon of AECOM USA, Inc.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. January 12, 2022, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Pierman presented the minutes of the January 12, 2022, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes and/or additions.

There being no changes, a **motion** was made by Mr. Marten, seconded by Mr. Bates and unanimously passed approving the minutes of the January 12, 2022, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

1. Discussion Regarding Canal Gates

Ms. Brandon explained that Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) had contacted her concerning an easement held by Hotwire inside the tract that the District was giving to LWDD. They have specified

that the Hotwire easement must be extinguished prior to LWDD accepting the land. Following discussion, Mr. Pierman noted that further investigation was needed, as this was not brought up in previous conversations. He further noted that now that both gates had been installed, he was working with the HOA to obtain fencing proposals which meet LWDD's requirements. Ms. Brandon also noted that she would contact the County regarding the guard rail along the road.

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2022-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Proposed Budget

Resolution No. 2022-01 was presented, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE JOURNEY'S END COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Discussion ensued regarding different scenarios in which the District pays off the debt early or makes a lump sum payment to reduce assessments. Mr. Pierman noted that he would work with Ms. Samuels to create a spreadsheet with all of the possibilities prior to the Public Hearing, and the Board could make a decision at that time.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Bates, seconded by Mr. Marten and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-01, as presented, setting the Public Hearing for July 7, 2022.

2. Discussion Regarding Lake Views, Early April 2022

Mr. Da Costa explained that he wanted the pictures in the book as a historical reference to review at a later date.

3. Consider 20-Year Stormwater Report Proposal

Mr. Pierman explained that the State had mandated that every District create a 20-Year Stormwater Report by June 30th. He presented the proposal to create the report from AECOM for a not-to-exceed amount of \$5,415.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Bates, seconded by Mr. Marten and passed unanimously approving the proposal from AECOM in the not to exceed amount of \$5,415 for the preparation of the 20-Year Stormwater Report.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

1. Financial Report

Mr. Pierman announced that the qualifying period runs from June 13th to the 17th, noting that Seats 4 and 5 (Mr. Da Costa and Vacant, respectively) were up for election this year. He also reminded the Board to submit their Form 1's.
